

Map & Directions



Pilanesberg Game Reserve

A suitable road map is recommended to follow the route properly, or to trace the route required from other parts of Gauteng, such as Johannesburg International Airport.

The lodge can be contacted at **014 556 8100** should assistance with directions be required en-route to Ivory Tree. No entry fees are charged for access directly to Ivory Tree through Bakgatla Gate.

Leave Johannesburg driving past Lanseria Airport (0km) towards Hartebeespoort Dam (suggested routes either William Nicol or Hans Strydom roadways)

3/18/2014 Map & Directions

(17.2km) At the T-junction of Broederstroom (fruit stall in front of you) turn left.
(29.7km) Follow signs to Sun City turning right taking the bridge over the dam.
(35.5km) At 4-way stop turn left (takes you past Chameleon Village) and at (40.7km) follow signs to Brits N4 Rustenburg taking you onto the N4.

Once on the N4 Toll road, take the 1st off-ramp (55.2km) for Pilanesberg/Sun City Turn right over the Highway continuing as though travelling to Sun City (± 80 km) going through at least four 4-way stops

(105.0km) Follow brown "Ivory Lodge" sign at a 4-way stop with a Golden Era sign off to the right, turn right to "Northam" on the R510

Continue along until you pass an industrial area on your left, soon after turn left (127.0km) follow brown "Ivory Lodge" sign to Mogwase and Pilanesberg (131.4km) At second stop street with a Caltex garage on the corner turn right to Pilanesberg, Manyane & Bakgatla Gates follow brown "Ivory Lodge" sign Continue until you hit a T-junction (144.6km) follow brown "Ivory Lodge" sign Turn left to Bakgatla Gate and George Stegman Hospital

Continue along this road which takes you to our driveway which is a huge thatched
